**Undergraduate (Includes Dental Hygiene):** 1-8½ units or over 18 units = \$1,095 per unit; 9-11 units = \$1,380 per unit, plus fees.

**Pharmacy:** 1-8½ units or over 19 units = \$1,159 per unit; 9-11 units = \$1,461 per unit, plus fees.

**Graduate (Includes Physical Therapy):** 1-15½ units or over 18 units = \$992 per unit, plus fees (except ASUOP Fee) for 9 units and above.

Students entering the University of the Pacific for the first time, please add a Matriculation Fee of \$100.

For Conservatory of Music students, please add a Conservatory Fee of \$250.00 per semester.

For School of Engineering and Computer Sciences, please add an Engineering/Computer Science Fee of \$150.00 per semester.

### PAYMENT PLANS

#### TOTAL UNIVERSITY COSTS - (SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS, LOANS) = AMOUNT DUE

**Semester Plan - General  
Monthly Plan**

- One payment due by August 1, 2009 and January 1, 2010.
- Four payments for Fall due: August 1, September 1, October 1, and November 1
- Four payments for Spring due: January 1, February 1, March 1, and April 1

**Semester Plan - Pharmacy  
Monthly Plan**

- One payment due by August 1, 2009, December 1, 2009, and April 1, 2010.
- Four payments for Fall due: August 1, September 1, October 1, and November 1
- Four payments for Winter due: December 1, January 1, February 1, and March 1
- Four payments for Spring due: April 1, May 1, June 1, and July 1.

Enrollment in the monthly payment plan requires a Deferred Fee of \$75 per semester/term.

Students must remit their payment for the semester, less deposits and any completed financial aid (scholarships, grants, and loans) by the payment deadline for the plans listed above. Payments not received by the 5th of the month will be assessed a late fee.
