What is the Evening Degree Program?

The Evening Degree Program is designed to meet the work schedules of adult learners who would like to earn a Bachelor of Science Degree in Organizational Behavior. It provides an atmosphere in which adult learners work cooperatively with each other and with faculty members in achieving their educational goals.

What is Organizational Behavior?

The Bachelor of Science degree program in Organizational Behavior focuses on the interdisciplinary study of social interaction and social change, incorporating the group dynamics involved in planning for change in business and organizations in the 21st Century.

How long will it take me to earn my degree?

The Evening Degree Program covers the last 2 years of a 4-year degree program, and then condenses those 2 years into an intensified twenty month program. In those twenty months, you will earn 54 units of coursework to be applied toward the 124 units required for the Bachelor of Science Degree.

How often will I be attending classes?

You will attend class every Tuesday and Thursday night from 5:30pm to 9:30pm.

What do I need to be accepted into the Evening Degree Program?

To be accepted for admission, you will need the following:

- A minimum of 60 transferable semester units of credit from an accredited college or university
- A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.50
- Completion of 80% of University of the Pacific's general education requirements (approximately 10 courses).
