1...ARREST STADIUM & PACIFIC AVE. 120306
Officers observed a vehicle in the middle of the street with the door open and the engine running at high speed. They observed two subjects in the vehicle unconscious. Officers summoned the assistance of medics who were able to awaken the driver. The passenger had to be transported to St. Joseph's Hospital for alcohol poisoning. The driver was arrested and transported to the county jail. Both subjects were under the age of 21.

2...AUTO BURGLARY BROOKSIDE PARKING 120306
Victim reports someone entered his pick up and took stereo equipment. The suspects used a metal instrument which they jammed into the door lock.

3...AUTO BURGLARY LOT BEHIND FRATERNITIES 120306
Victim reports someone entered his SUV and took stereo equipment. Victim heard his alarm going off. He went outside and saw the suspect get out of his vehicle and get into a dark green Durango driven by another subject and take off from the lot. They entered his vehicle by punching out the lock. Victim's loss was a binder and \$400.

Officers initiated a report for an alcohol policy violation.

5...THEFT LONG'S THEATER LOT 120406
Reporting party stated someone siphoned gas out of a rented van parked over night.

6... THEFT LONG'S THEATER LOT 120406
Victim parked his Ford pickup at 11:45 AM and returned at 1:15 PM. He discovered his passenger door smashed and briefcase taken. Victim stated they did not take his wallet which was in plain view. Loss was the brief case with a Kodak camera, Motorola cell phone, and several other personal items.
