- 1...THEFT** **FAYE SPANOS CTR.** **053006**
Stockton Unified School District reports someone took one of their trombones that was left unattended in the hall.
- 2...VANDALISM** **ART BUILDING** **053006**
Staff reports one of their windows was broken out during the weekend.
- 3...TRAFFIC STOP** **BROOKSIDE RD** **053006**
Officers stopped a vehicle for traffic violations. Officers learned the driver did not have a license so the vehicle was towed.
- 4...ARREST** **PERSHING AND BROOKSIDE RD** **053106**
Officers observed a subject riding his bicycle at 5:00 AM. He was pulling another bike along his side. After the stop, officers located a crack pipe and other drug paraphernalia on his person. He was cited for the violations.
- 5...REPORT** **LIBRARY** **053106**
Subject reports he lost his cell phone.
