- 1...ASSIST OFFICERS MANCHESTER AVE 010107**
Officers assisted Stockton Police on a call of three subject possibly armed with handguns. Sgt Redfearn heard several gunshots coming from the area of Manchester. One subject was arrested. Stockton Police took charge.
- 2...THREATS O.I.T. 010207**
Staff of O.I.T. reports receiving a letter of extortion in the mail which was intended for an employee out of San Francisco. Officers conducted follow up and submitted reports to Stockton Police for further investigation.
- 3...AUTO BURGLARY CHAPEL PARKING 010207**
Victim reports finding her door unlocked. Suspects possible used a dent puller to pull out the core lock which disabled the factory alarm on the victim's Chevrolet Tahoe. Once inside, suspects went through the glove box and console storage. Victim did not notice anything missing.
- 4...GRAND THEFT COMMON ROOM 010307**
Suspects forced open the Pepsi machine in the Common Room and removed an undetermined amount of soda and coins from the machine.
- 5...CASUALTY HUMAN RESOURCES 010307**
Officers responded to assist an employee who was feeling ill. The employee was transported to Dameron Hospital for treatment.
- 6...SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT PACIFIC AVE BRIDGE 010307**
Subject reports someone threw a rock from under the bridge, striking the front of his vehicle. The rock traveled through the front grill and into the engine compartment. Officers assisted Stockton Police but were unable to locate the responsible.
- 7...TRAFFIC STOP KENSINGTON AVE. 010407**
Officers stopped a vehicle for traffic violations and determined the subjects' license was suspended. The driver was arrested for outstanding warrants and the vehicle was towed.
- 8...CASUALTY MORRIS CHAPEL 010507**
Officers responded to a report of an injured child. Officers determined the toddler tripped and fell, striking her head which resulted in a laceration. She was transported to St. Joseph's Hospital for treatment.

9...DISTURBANCE**236 W STADIUM****010607**

Officers responded to a call of a loud party. Officers made contact and detained two subjects who were booked for public intoxication and released the next morning.

10..VANDALISM**TOWNHOUSE PARKING****010607**

Subject reports finding someone scratched into the paint of the victim's vehicle.

11..ASSIST**835 LONGVIEW****010607**

Officers were called by Stockton Police to assist a subject hiding in the block after a theft. Subject was taken into custody by officers.

12..SUSPICIOUS PERSON**PERSHING & BROOKSIDE****010607**

Officers observed a subject attempting to kick over a bus stop and detained the subject. Officers determined he was under the influence. He was transported to county jail for detoxification.
