- 1...NARCOTICS** **SOUTHWEST HALL** **101407**
Officers responded to a report of a male subject smoking marijuana in his room. Subject was cited and property surrendered and voluntarily was destroyed.
- 2...VANDALISM** **GRACE COVELL** **101407**
Officers responded to a report of a male subject who had punched a hole in the wall. Officers investigated and determined who was responsible for the damage. Officer attempted to make contact with negative results. A report was initiated.
- 3...SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT** **KAPPA ALPHA THETA** **101407**
Officer responded to report of glass breaking in the area. Officers determined that nothing was vandalized and no damage to University property. There as some broken glass but officers were unable to determine where is came from.
