- 1...AIDED SUSD PD ALPINE AVE 061508**
Officer assisted SUSD PD with two in custody off campus. Officers cleared call for a fire alarm at Southwest Hall.
- 2...VANDALISM SOUTHWEST HALL 061508**
Officers responded to a fire alarm. Officers determined someone had tampered with the fire equipment and set off an extinguisher inside.
- 3...AIDED SPD DAVE BRUBECK 061508**
Officer assisted Stockton PD who were involved in an officer involved shooting at the Carousel Apartments.
- 4...VEHICLE ACCIDENT PACIFIC & PRESIDENT'S DR 061608**
Officer reported a vehicle accident with one of the drivers unconscious and stuck inside the vehicle. Nobody from the campus community were involved in the accident. SFD and SPD responded to assist. SPD initiated the report.
- 5...SUSPICIOUS PERSON FAYE SPANOS 061608**
Officers responded to a report of a male subject sitting in the lobby for a approximately an hour. Officer contacted the subject and a records check determined the subject was reported missing from South Carolina and suffers from a mental illness. Subject was transported to a local hospital.

Victim reported her vehicle was broken into. Entry was made through the driver side back window. Glove compartment had been gone through yet, nothing taken.
- 7...WARRANT ARREST CALAVERAS BIKE PATH 061808**
Officer initiated checkout of a male subject on a bicycle south of the tennis courts. Officer learned the subject had an outstanding felony no bail bench warrant.
