- 1...SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT KENSINGTON WY 101908**
Officer conducted a checkout on a male subject. Subject was interviewed and revoked from campus.

Officers assisted SPD on a report of a citizen having one detained for the theft of her bicycle. Officers made contact and determined victim did not want to file charges at this time.
- 3...CASUALTY PACIFIC & KNOLES 101908**
Officer and medics responded to a report of a male subject unconscious in the crosswalk. Subject was transported to a local hospital via ambulance.
- 4...VANDALISM BONNIE & FULTON 101908**
Victim reported the rear driver side mirror was smashed. Officer responded and initiated a report.
