

## Fulbright Timeline and Deadlines

Summertime: This is when you jump start your research and writing. Take advantage of your less busy months! Send me drafts and ideas as often as you like.

First two weeks of September: Individual meetings. Please set these up with me via email. Continue to send me drafts and brainstorming in this period.

September 16: First draft of both essays due. This is a draft. But it should be a full draft, not a bunch of thoughts.

Week of September 20: Individual meetings about first draft. This can be on the phone, for those of you who are not on campus.

Weekend of September 25: Revision.

September 27: Submit revision by 9am.

September 28-October 1: Individual meetings.

October 1: Final draft of both essays due for your on-campus evaluation, along with all recommendations, letter of affiliation, transcripts. This is for your campus interviewers, and **not** for the Fulbright Commission. Your interviewers need to read your dossier ahead of time.

Week of October 4: Campus interview. This is a 20-30 minute interview with two professors and the Fellowship Advisor. Past applicants have found it very helpful for the final revision of the essays.

Week of October 11: Final individual meetings.
