

Fraternity and Sorority Community Report Executive Summary

In addition to our fraternities and sororities, this report is sent to stakeholders to inform them about the Pacific fraternity and sorority community. On the reverse side is the statistical report for Spring 2012, last verified on June 4, 2012.

Scholarship

The Pacific fraternity and sorority GPA (3.04) is above the Pacific Undergraduate GPA (2.99)

Delta Delta Delta, Delta Gamma, Gamma Alpha Omega and Kappa Alpha Theta achieved an Overall GPA at or above the Overall Pacific undergraduate female GPA

Beta Theta Pi, Pi Kappa Alpha, Sigma Chi, Theta Chi and Xi Chi Sigma achieved an Overall GPA at or above the Overall Pacific undergraduate male GPA

The overall sorority GPA increased 0.02 from a 3.06 in Fall 2011 to 3.08 in the Spring 2012 semester

The overall fraternity GPA increased 0.06 from a 2.94 in Fall 2011 to 3.00 in the Spring 2012 semester

The overall F/S community GPA increased 0.03 from 3.01 in Fall 2011 to 3.04 in the Spring 2012 semester

The average semester GPA for new member classes within the Panhellenic Council community was 3.03

The average semester GPA for new member classes within the Interfraternity Council community was 2.88

The average semester GPA for new member classes within the Multicultural Greek Council community was 2.34

Membership

The total membership of the F/S community increased 23.6% from 493 in Fall 2011 to 645 in the Spring 2012 semester

The percentage of undergraduate students in fraternities and sororities increased from 15% to 19% into the Spring 2012 semester

Service & Philanthropy

The fraternity and sorority community increased the number of recorded community service hours 10.4% from the previous semester

The fraternity and sorority community decreased the number of recorded philanthropy dollars 76% from the previous semester

Leadership

IMPACT, a campus based leadership institute, hosted by the North American Interfraternity Council was held off-site and attended by 70 members of the Greek community.
