Students residing in First or Second Year Communities must participate in at least a **Silver Meal Plan** each semester/term. Unused Dining Points are forfeited at the end of each year and are nontransferable. **Students are allowed to carry-over 300 Dining Points from the fall to spring term. Students who wish to change their meal plan, must do so prior to the beginning of the semester/term. No decreases will be allowed once the semester/term has begun.**
