Regent's, President's Provost's Dean's, and Pacific Scholarship

Payment

To receive your academic scholarship, you must have enrolled in the fall semester of the academic year you were admitted as a full-time freshman student. Half the scholarship will be deposited in your student account toward payments of fall tuition, and half will be deposited in your account for spring.

Renewal Requirements

To retain your scholarship, you must maintain full-time enrollment at Pacific in a bachelor's or preprofessional program, earn the required overall University of the Pacific grade point average, and make satisfactory progress toward completion of your degree.

Duration of Eligibility

Academic scholarships received in the freshman year may be renewed for full-time enrollment in a bachelor's degree program for up to a total of four years (*eight semesters*) of scholarship support, or for Engineering students, up to five years (*ten semesters*).

These scholarships can only be applied to undergraduate coursework. As such, these scholarships cannot be applied to professional coursework in the School of Pharmacy, Dentistry, or Law.

Other Terms and Conditions

If you have also applied for local scholarships or need-based financial aid, please note that total assistance from all sources, including this academic award, cannot exceed your costs of attendance. If you receive *need-based* funds, the total of your academic scholarships plus need-based aid will be limited to your calculated financial need. In addition, the combined value of these scholarships and any other *tuition* award (such as Cal Grant) cannot exceed actual tuition and fee charges. Total tuition assistance may also be limited by policies associated with other programs or benefits, such as employee tuition remission or a Tuition Exchange scholarship. If necessary, the Office of Financial Aid will coordinate your award package and will notify you of any adjustments.

If you are selected for more than one Pacific academic scholarships, with the exception of the Dean's and Pacific Scholarships, you will receive the most advantageous award.
