Students are allowed to carry-over up to 300 Dining Points from the Fall to Spring term for General Term & Law Term and from Fall to Spring to Summer for Health Sciences Term. No decreases will be allowed without prior approval once a meal plan has been selected. Meal Plan increases will be accepted at any given time during the academic year.
