## **Room and Meal Plan Rates and Requirements**

**ROOM AND MEAL PLAN RATES**: Room and meal plan charges are assessed by the semester/term and are due as billed by the Office of Student Accounts. There are two semesters for General Term (Fall and Spring) and three semesters for Pharmacy & Health Sciences Term students (Fall, Spring, and Summer). Rates and amounts are subject to change.

MEAL PLAN REQUIREMENTS: All students living on campus are required to purchase a Meal Plan. Minimum meal plans vary between Residence Halls and Apartment Communities and are based on the amenities available within the facility. Unused Dining Points are forfeited at the end of each academic year and are nontransferable. Students are allowed to carry-over up to 300 Dining Points from the Fall to Spring term for General Term and from Fall to Spring to Summer for Pharmacy & Health Sciences Term. No decreases will be allowed without prior approval once a meal plan has been selected. Meal Plan increases will be accepted at any given time during the academic year.
