WHAT TO DO UPON YOUR ARRIVAL

1. Parking – You can park anywhere on campus to check your student into the program. The closest lot to park is lot 7.
2. Check-In at the DeRosa University Center. You will receive your:
 - Student ID
 - Key to your room
 - Welcome gifts
3. Proceed to your residence hall and get settled into your room.
4. After 9 a.m. you can go on a campus tour, hosted by the Office of Admissions.
5. At 11:00 a.m. you are to attend the Summer Institute Orientation on Knoles Lawn. Lunch will be provided.
6. From 12:15 p.m. students are transitioning to their programs. Look for your program sign, where you will meet with your Faculty Lead.
7. At 12:45 p.m. your program staff will walk with you to your academic or athletics program, in which you will be participating until 5 p.m.
8. At 5:00 p.m. you will be escorted to the DeRosa University Center, where dinner will be served from 5–7:30 p.m. and you will participate in various Community Building programs.
9. At 9:00 p.m. you will connect with your Resident Assistant and meet your roommate.



DAY 2

1. Breakfast will be available starting at 7 a.m. in the DeRosa University Center.
2. At 8:45 a.m., you will meet with your academic program group on the DeRosa University Center Lawn and you will walk together to class.
 - You are walked to class on the first two days, to help you get oriented on our campus and to ensure that you are finding your way.
3. The program sessions will begin promptly at 9 a.m. and conclude at 4 p.m., with breaks and lunch during this time.
4. On select days, you will participate in engaging and interactive workshops centered around topics that help prepare you for college. In the evenings, you can participate in a variety of fun co-curricular activities and games, including time for recreational sports, swimming, arts and crafts and more.
5. You will have to be back to your living spaces by 10 p.m., as all students are to be in bed (with lights out) by 11 p.m.
