(Current University 2025-2026 Guidelines)

**Everyone regardless of vaccination status, previous infection.**

**California Department of Public Health Guidelines for Healthcare and Non Healthcare Workers are included**

<p align="center"><b>Do you have COVID-19 <u>symptoms</u>?</b></p>	<p align="center"><b>Consult with your healthcare provider to determine the need for a COVID-19 test.</b> Students should contact the Student Health Center (209.946.2315 Option 1) to schedule or pick up a test.</p>
<p align="center"><b>Do you have a COVID-19 positive test result?</b></p>	<p><b>ALL MUST Report your positive test through the Pacific COVID-19 reporting form (<a href="#">LINK</a>).</b> <b>If you are Staff or Faculty, you will receive instructions from Human Resources</b></p> <p><b>ALL STUDENTS ENROLLED in one of the Health Science Programs, Dugoni Dentistry, or Pharmacy ARE NOT ABLE TO ATTEND CLASS OR CLINICS UNTIL YOU TEST NEGATIVE:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ <b>You must speak with a provider at Student Health Services, you will receive a call after completing the link.</b></li> <li>✓ Wear a well-fitting mask when around others through Day 10</li> </ul> <p><b>ALL STUDENTS NOT enrolled in one of the Health Science Programs, Dugoni Dentistry or Pharmacy, see below:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Report positive test via the reporting (<a href="#">LINK</a>). <b>This will prompt a call from Student Health Services</b></li> </ul> <p><b>If you do not have a fever and are only experiencing MILD or no symptoms:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ You may attend class but <b>MUST Mask</b> when you are around other people indoors for 10 days after you become sick or test positive OR you have two sequential negative tests at least one day apart.</li> <li>✓ <b>Any questions should be directed to <a href="#">Human Resources</a> (employees) or Student Health Center (students)</b></li> </ul> <p><b>If you are a student, please contact your professors ASAP to inform them of any required medical absences.</b></p>
<p align="center"><b>Close Contact<sup>1</sup> Exposure without Symptoms</b></p>	<p><b>Test within the first 3 days after exposure, repeat test 5-6 days after exposure.</b> <b>Wear a mask</b> around others. If symptoms develop, or test positive, follow the isolation recommendations above.</p>

<sup>1</sup> "Close contact" is defined as being within 6 feet of someone with the virus for a *cumulative total* of 15 minutes (or more) over a 24-hour period
