Do you have COVID-19 <u>symptoms</u> ?	Consult with your healthcare provider to determine the need for a COVID-19 test. Students should contact the Student Health Center (209.946.2315 Option 1) to schedule or pick up a test.
Do you have a COVID-19 positive test result?	ALL MUST Report your positive test through the Pacific COVID-19 reporting form (LINK). If you are Staff or Faculty, you will receive instructions from Human Resources
	ALL STUDENTS ENROLLED in one of the Health Science Programs, Dugoni Dentistry, or Pharmacy ARE NOT ABLE TO ATTEND CLASS OR CLINICS UNTIL YOU TEST NEGATIVE:
	 ✓ You must speak with a provider at Student Health Services, you will receive a call after completing the link. ✓ Wear a well-fitting mask when around others through Day 10
	ALL STUDENTS NOT enrolled in one of the Health Science Programs, Dugoni Dentistry or Pharmacy, see below: ✓ Report positive test via the reporting (LINK). This will prompt a call from Student Health Services If you do not have a fever and are only experiencing MILD or no symptoms:
	✓ You may attend class but MUST Mask when you are around other people indoors for 10 days after you become sick or test positive OR you have two sequential negative tests at lest one day apart.
	Any questions should be directed to Human Resources (employees) or Student Health Center (students) If you are a student, please contact your professors ASAP to inform them of any required medical absences.
Close Contact ¹ Exposure without Symptoms	Test within the first 3 days after exposure, repeat test 5-6 days after exposure. Wear a mask around others. If symptoms develop, or test positive, follow the isolation recommendations above.

¹ "Close contact" is defined as being within 6 feet of someone with the virus for a cumulative total of 15 minutes (or more) over a 24-hour period
