Title: "DIY Milling: What Does it Take?"

Course Description:

What if you could keep more procedures in-house, reduce referrals, and maximize same-day dentistry? The 9.3-micron CO2 all-tissue laser enables you to perform more high-value procedures—such as gingivectomies, frenectomies, and flapless crown lengthening—by minimizing bleeding, sutures and post-operative pain. Plus, by reducing the need for anesthesia in many cases, you create a more efficient, patient-friendly experience that sets your practice apart.
