The ECP is a forum of distinguished cultural figures from across Europe—including politicians, artists, architects, and educators—bringing together leaders in the arts, education, and cultural diplomacy. Its mission is to foster dialogue, strengthen cooperation, and promote shared values across borders.

As part of this appointment, Wolny will also serve on the board of the Transatlantic Dialogue Conference, one of the flagship initiatives of the ECP.

This summer, 37 students traveled to Salzburg, Austria on McGeorge's annual Faculty-Led Trip to study Law and International Legal Studies! This trip included 3 courses related to law, guest lectures from special speakers, a day trip to Vienna, and visits to two UNESCO sites.


Semester at Sea




