Room and Meal Plan Rates and Requirements

ROOM AND MEAL PLAN RATES: Room and meal plan charges are assessed by the semester/term and are due as billed by the Office of Student Accounts. There are two semesters for General Term (fall and spring) and three semesters for Pharmacy Term students (fall, spring and summer). Rates and amounts are subject to change.

MEAL PLAN REQUIREMENTS: First and Second Year students are required to select a minimum Silver Meal Plan each semester/term. Seniors, Juniors and Graduate/Pharmacy students have the option of selecting from all five meal plans. Unused Dining Points are forfeited at the end of each academic year and are nontransferable. Students are allowed to carry-over up to 300 Dining Points from the fall to spring term for General Term and from fall to spring to summer for Pharmacy Term. Students who wish to modify their meal plan, must do so prior to the beginning of the semester/term. No decreases will be approved after the first day of the semester/term.
