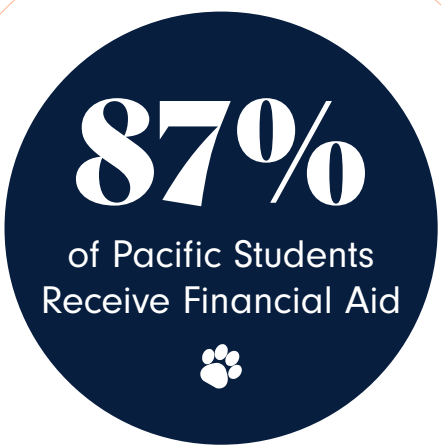
Take courses that meet Pacific's business degree requirements:

- Microeconomics: ECON 304
- Macroeconomics: ECON 1A or ECON 302
- Writing: ENGL 1B or ENGWR 301
- Calculus: MATH 341 or MATH 343
- Statistics: STAT 001 or STAT 300
- Public Speaking: COMM 1 or COMM 301
- Computer Science: CISC 310
- Financial Accounting: ACCT 301
- Managerial Accounting: ACCT 311
- Business Law: BUS 340

And, take courses that meet Pacific's general education requirements:

- One course in Artistic Process and Creation (GEAP)*
- One course in Scientific Inquiry (GESI)*
- One course in World Perspectives and Ethics (GEWE)*
