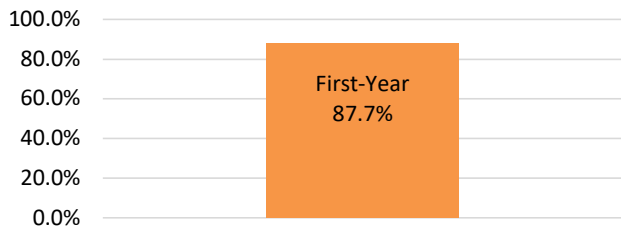

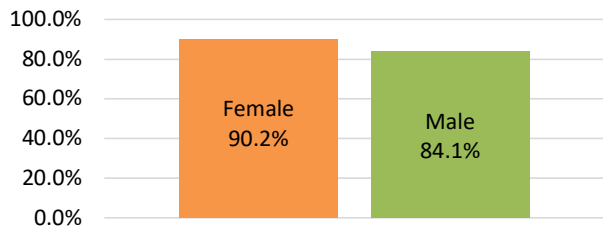

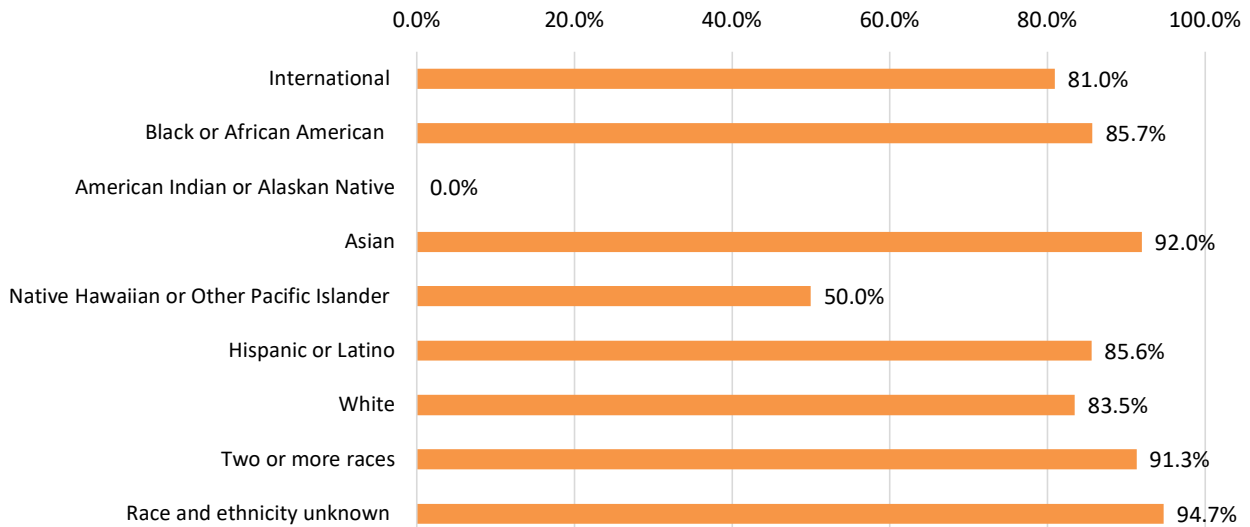
**Retention to the 2nd Year
