WHAT TO DO UPON YOUR ARRIVAL

1. Parking- You can park anywhere on campus to check your student into the program. The closest lot to park is lot 7.
2. Check-In at the DeRosa University Center.
You will receive your:

3. Proceed to your residence hall and get settled into your room.
4. Once you are done getting settled, you can go on a tour, hosted by the Office of Admissions, to familiarize yourself with campus.
5. At 12:00 p.m. you will be escorted to Faye Spanos Concert Hall for Orientation.
6. At 1:00 p.m. you will meet with your Faculty Lead who will walk with you to your academic program, in which you will be participating until 5 p.m.
7. Dinner will be served from 5–6 p.m. on Knoles Lawn.
8. At 6:30 p.m. you will connect with your Resident Assistant and meet your roommate.



DAY 2

1. Breakfast will be available starting at 7 a.m. in the DeRosa University Center.
2. At 8:45 a.m., you will meet on the DeRosa University Center Lawn to meet up with your academic program group and you will walk together to the class. (This will take place on the first two days of camp to help you get oriented to the campus and ensure you are finding your way).
3. SHSI class sessions will begin promptly at 9 a.m. and conclude at 4 p.m., with breaks and lunch during this time.
4. On select days, you will participate in engaging and interactive workshops centered around topics that help prepare you for college. In the evenings, you can participate in a variety of fun co-curricular activities and games, including time for recreational sports, swimming, arts and crafts, and more.
